

# Cambodia 6 nights / 7 days

# Day 01 Hong Kong – Phnom Penh



Royal Palace

Depart Hong Kong, arrive Phnom Penh, meet and greet, hotel transfer. Afternoon visit **Royal Palace** in old town where you can also see spectacular buildings such as the **Fifty Nine Meter Tower**, **Royal Treasury**, **Napoleon II Villa** and **Silver Pagoda**.

See the **National Museum**, a true architectural gem, instantly recognizable by the warm red terracotta and the gracefully curved roof topped by dozens of guardian Nagas.

Evening hotel transfer, overnight Phnom Penh.

## Day 02 Phnom Penh

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel, start your day with **Choeung Ek**, learn about the historical importance of this place and the seventeen thousand individuals who suffered through interrogations, torture and deprivation in **Toul Sleng Prison**.

Continue to **Toul Sleng Museum** followed by **Wat Phnom**, a Buddhist Temple famous for being the tallest religious structure in the city; many people come here to pray for good luck and success. Lunch served at a local restaurant.

Visit the **Russian Market** (Psah Toul Tom Poung) antiquities, silver, gold jewellery, gems, silk stone and wood carvings can be found here. Head to **Victoria Monument** built to celebrate independence from the French.

Evening hotel transfer, overnight Phnom Penh.

#### Day 03 Phnom Penh – Siem Reap



Ta Prohm

Hotel breakfast, drive to Siem Reap, hotel transfer. Afternoon sightseeing of **Ta Prohm**, one of the area's most beautiful temples, this small but classic monument remains relatively untouched. Lunch served at a local restaurant.

Continue to **Preah Khan Temple**, like Ta Prohm, a place of towered enclosures and shoulder hugging corridors. End your evening with a **Khmer Traditional Dance** at a local restaurant with dinner, hotel transfer, overnight Siem Reap.

#### Day 04 Siem Reap

Breakfast at hotel, visit **Angkor Thom**, the structure encloses residences, priest, officials of the palace and military. Lunch will be served at a local restaurant.

Later visit **Angkor Wat** the most famous of all the temples, a *UNESCO World Heritage Site*, see the series of elevated towers, covered galleries, chambers, porches and courtyards on different levels linked by stairways. The entire area is visually, architecturally and artistically breathtaking.

# Day 05 Siem Reap



Banteay Samre

Enjoy breakfast in the comfort of your hotel; tour begins with **Banteay Srei**, a Cambodian temple dedicated to the Hindu god Shiva, largely built in red sandstone with elaborate decorative wall carvings that are still observable. See **Banteay Samre**, whose special charm lies in the remarkable state of preservation, small size and excellent design.

Afternoon city sightseeing includes **Prasaht Kravan** consisting of five reddish brick towers, the most impressive being Tower One. See **Srah Srang** (*Royal Bath*) once used for ritual bathing, explore **Banteay Kdei** a Buddhist temple and **Ta Keo**. Lunch served at a local restaurant, evening hotel transfer, overnight Siem Reap.



### Day 06 Siem Reap



Angkor Silk Farm

Hotel breakfast, visit **Angkor Silk Farm** at Puok followed by **Les Artisans D' Angkor**, home of craftsman centre and **Phas Chas**; a lively outdoor market. Lunch served at a local restaurant.

Afternoon trip to **Tonle Sap Lake**, enjoy a brief cruise past floating villages with schools, restaurants and hospitals. Evening hotel transfer, overnight Siem Reap.

Enjoy breakfast in the comfort of your hotel, airport transfer, depart Siem Reap, arrive Hong Kong.
