Day 01 Welcome to Budapest (D)



Fisherman's Bastion

Arrive in Budapest, hotel transfer, your guided city tour will grant you, above others, a stunning panorama over the city from the **Fisherman's Bastion**.

Welcome dinner will be served in a typical Hungarian specialty restaurant.

Overnight: Hotel Novotel Centrum (or similar), dinner (D) included.

Day 02 Budapest – Belgrade (B, L & D)

In the morning you will embark from your private Pullman Car at the station **Keleti Pu**. Choose your favourite seat and enjoy the beautiful landscape passing.

In the early evening you will arrive in the Serbian capital of Belgrade, hotel transfer, check-in and relax. Enjoy an atmospheric dinner in the street **Skadarlija**, well known for its bustling nightlife.

Overnight: Hotel Moskva (or similar), breakfast (B), lunch (L) & dinner included.

Day 03 Belgrade (B & L)



Kalemegdan Fortress

Today you are going on a city tour, including the **Kalemegdan Fortress**, the **Tito Mausoleum**, the **Town Hall** and the main boulevard **Knez Mihajlova**.

Overnight: Hotel Moskva (or similar), breakfast & lunch included.

Day 04 Sargan 8 and the Bridge over the Drina (B, L & D)

In the morning you will travel in your Pullman Car from Belgrade to Pozega, one of the most beautiful tracks in Europe. After lunch you will visit the **Narrow Gauge Railway Museum**.

Travel with the unique 760 mm narrow gauge railway **Šargan Eight**, from the sky the tracks looks like the number eight. Starting in Mokra Gora, this panoramic trip leads you over the scarps of the **Sargan Pass** and offers stunning views over the mountains.

After the trip, a short transfer by bus will bring you to **Visegrad** where you will visit the *UNESCO World Heritage Site* of the **Drina River Bridge**. Afterwards you will reach your destination; Sarajevo.

Overnight: Hotel Europe (or similar) breakfast, lunch & dinner included.

Day 05 Sarajevo (B & L)



Latin Bridge

This city offers oriental flair; get to know the **Bazaar**, the **Tunnel Museum** and the **Latin Bridge** over the river **Miljacka**. This is the where the Austrian heir apparent Franz Ferdinand was murdered.

Spend the afternoon in the spa town of **Iidza** and enjoy a carriage ride to the **Vrelo Bosne Spring**.

Overnight: Hotel Europe (or similar), breakfast & lunch included.

Day 06 The Tara Canyon (B & D)

You will get back to the railway line Belgrade-Bar by bus. In Uzice your Pullman Car awaits you, continue the journey southwards.

The closer you come to the **Serbian-Montenegrin Border**, the more spectacular the landscape gets. In the afternoon you will arrive in Kolasin.

Overnight: Hotel Bianca Resort (or similar), breakfast & dinner included.

Day 07 The Tara Canyon (B & D)

On a panoramic routing your train follows the river **Tara** to **Durmitor National Park**. The Tara is the longest river of the country and has created the deepest canyon in Europe, which is the second deepest canyon in the world and part of the *UNESCO World Heritage*. Pass an impressive 150m high arch bridge.

Back in Kolasin, your private train awaits for the last part of the train journey, in Montenegro you will enjoy the breath-taking routing over the **Moraca Gorge** and the 498m long and 198m high **Mala-Rijeka-Viaduct**. Welcome to the highest railway bridge in Europe! After arriving in Bar at the Adriatic Sea you will check-in to your hotel.

Overnight: Hotel Princess (or similar), breakfast & dinner included.

Day 08 The Skadar Lake and the city of Cetinje (B & D)



Lake Skadar

Your day starts with a boat ride over **Lake Skadar**; a paradise for ornithologists, see one of the biggest bird sanctuaries in Europe with 270 species.

Visit the historic capital Cetinje, on the way to the Adriatic Sea by bus, enjoy wonderful views over the bay of Kotor. In Kotor you will do a short city walk before enjoying dinner at the port of Budva, overnight Bar.

Overnight: Hotel Princess (or similar), breakfast & dinner included.

Day 09 Dubrovnik and the Bay of Kotor (B & D)

By bus you will circle the **Bay of Kotor**, belonging to the *UNESCO World Heritage* before arriving at Dubrovnik. Stop at **Perast**, one of the most beautiful baroque cities at the Adriatic Sea. With the help of small boats you will reach the island “*Our Lady of the Rocks*”.

In the afternoon you will arrive in Dubrovnik. On a guided city tour you will discover the old town with the small streets, fountains, big and small squares, monasteries and churches.
