

Go to Guilin 6 days / 5 nights From HKD11,150 up per person Guilin – Longsheng – Guilin – Yangshuo

Day 1 – Hong Kong – Guilin – Longsheng

Depart Hong Kong and **arrive** in **Guilin** via *Dragonair* (*approx. flight time 1hr. 25mins.*), enjoy your *meet and greet* prior to your hotel transfer to Longsheng. Check in and spend the rest of the day doing as you please.

Lunch is included today.

Day 2 – Longsheng – Guilin



Longji Terraces

You shall spend the day trekking through Longsheng to see the **Longji Terraces**, an area famous for beautiful terraced rice paddy fields on the mountain. Discover the intricate patterns on the hillsides, set amongst the villages of the Zhuang and Yao minorities. See the interesting style of architecture found in forest-fringed villages as you gain insight into daily rural life. *Longji* means *Dragon Backed Mountain*; when the paddies are full of water in spring the mountain is said to resemble the scales on the

back of a dragon. Peruse the local Yao women doing their hair combing performance in the water.

In the evening you shall be escorted back to Guilin.

Lunch is included today.

Day 3 – Guilin

In the morning your tour shall begin with the **Reed Flute Cave**. Her name derives from the reeds using for making flutes and pipes that grow at the entrance. Housing stalactites, stalagmites, stone pillars, birds, plants and animals; regarded as the largest cave in *Guilin*.

Elephant Trunk Hill

Next, you will be escorted to **Elephant Trunk Hill**, located at the confluence of *Li River* and *Peach Blossom River*. The *Water Moon* Cave is nearby; you will notice that it appears a moon is floating in the water. The view from here is very peaceful.

Fubo Hill is located on the west bank of the *Li River*, partially submerged. Named after *General Fubo*, designed to tame the waves and

stop surging waters form creating whirlpools. There are almost 350 steps to climb to reach the top of the hill; the wonderful view is well worth the journey.

Your day shall end with a peaceful boat ride on the **Two Rivers and Four Lakes Cruise** (*approx. 90 mins.*). You shall be escorted across four lakes and two rivers during the evening, when the scenery is spectacularly floor lit. Half way through the ride there shall be a demonstration of traditional cormorant fishing.

Lunch and dinner are included today.

Day 4 – Guilin – Yangshuo

In the morning you shall be escorted on-board the **Li River Cruise** from Guilin to Yangshuo. See gorgeous Karst peaks, the calm blue sky and the limpid river. Water buffalos patrol the fields, locals can be seen reaping rice paddies while school children and fishermen float by on bamboo rafts. This wonderful scenery gives a taste of life far removed from the concrete metropolis, considered one of China's top tourist destinations.



Li River

Yangshuo is a wonderful place surrounded by Karst peaks, winding rivers and beautiful scenery, famous for rivers, caves, temples and more. You may notice that there is a relatively large community of ex-pats. This area is considered a very clean place by Chinese standards. In the afternoon you can stroll through **Yangshuo Market**.





Impression Liu Sanjie

In the evening you can enjoy the **Impression Liu Sanjie** (*approx. 70 mins.*). Brought to you by the producer that did the Beijing Olympic Games opening ceremony this grand and impressive show is an excellent way to end your day. Set to the music from the movie of the same name, featuring a cast of over six hundred dressed in traditional Zhuang, Miao and Yao clothes. A highly impressive light show, *Liu Sanjie* translates to *Third sister Liu*, who is the heroine of an old Chinese story.

Lunch and dinner are included today.

Day 5 – Yangshuo

Start your morning with a countryside tour to **Moon Hill** via bicycle, wandering through the countryside on a bike is a thoroughly enjoyable activity. Pass by villages that have dramatic mountain backdrops, see friendly locals going about their peaceful lives and breathe in the fresh air during your ride.

In the afternoon your tour will conclude with bamboo rafting over the **Yulong River**. This is a small tributary of the larger *Li River*, starting

in Northern Yangshuo County near Litang and stretching over 35km. through small villages including Putao, Litang, Chaolong, Yima, Gaotian town and emptying around the town of Ping Le.

Lunch is included today.

Day 6 – Yangshuo – Guilin – Hong Kong

Take your hotel transfer to Guilin prior to heading to the airport for your flight **departing Guilin** and **arriving** in **Hong Kong** via *Dragonair* (*approx. flight time 1hr. 25mins.*).
