

Golden Triangle 04 Nights / 05 Days

Day 01 Hong Kong - Delhi

Depart Hong Kong, arrive Delhi, meet and greet, hotel transfer, overnight Delhi.


Day 02 Delhi – Agra (205kms / 4.5hrs)

Enjoy breakfast in the comfort of your hotel, afterwards your private tour of Old & New Delhi shall commence with **Red Fort**. A *UNESCO World Heritage Site*, named for the red sandstone walls, constructed by the Mughal Emperor Shah Jehan.

Continue to the imperial avenue known as **Chandi Chowk**, pass through narrow alleyways until you arrive at **Jama Masjid**; the largest Muslim mosque in India.

Qutub Minar

Experience a **Rickshaw Ride** and visit **Qutub Minar** followed by **India Gate**; a 42 meter archway built in memory of the India soldiers killed during the First World War. From here you can see the contrast of Old and New Delhi.

Private tour continues with a drive past **Rashtrapati Bhawan**, which was initially constructed as the Imperial residence of the Viceroy in the early 20th century, currently used as the residence for the President of India and Parliament House. Admire this unique circular architecture that was built with huge colonades which house the Upper and Lower House of Parliament.

Proceed to the **Government Secretariat Buildings** as Connaught Place, a shopping centre is located nearby if you wish to shop around.

Drive to Agra, hotel transfer, overnight Agra.



Day 03 Agra – Fatehpur Sikri – Jaipur (232kms / 06hrs)

Wake up early and be rewarded with a beautiful sunrise at the **Taj Mahal**, the inimitable poem of love constructed in white marble from the 17th century. Start your day with seeing the sun rise upon this great monument prior to heading back to the hotel for breakfast.

Your private tour begins with **Agra Fort**, located on the banks of the **River Yamuna**, an imposing structure replete with priceless examples of craftsmanship from the Mughal period including the incredible Pearl Mosque from the 16th century.

Drive to Jaipur (232km /06hrs) and visit **Fatehpur Sikri** on the way, learn of the fascinating story of the Muslim Saint, Sheikh Salim Chishti and how Akbar heard of him and eventually named a mighty and ambitious project after him, the project an entire city located near the residence of the saint in the 16th century. Visit **Salim Chishti Mosque, Panch Mahal** and other Palaces.

Evening continue to Jaipur, hotel transfer, overnight Jaipur.

Day 04 Jaipur

Hotel breakfast full day sightseeing begins with **Amber Fort**, set in a picturesque location, a fascinating blend of Hindu and Muslim architecture. Built in the 16th century by Raja Mansingh in red sandstone and white marble, the complex has some interesting apartments. Points of interest include **Jai Mandir**, **Sheesh Mahal**, **Sukh Niwas**, **Ganesh Pol** and **Temple of Kali**. Elephants are provided to ascend the fort (*between 0730 – 1130hrs, subject to availability*).

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Visit **Jaipur City** and see **Maharaja's City Palace**, the home of the erstwhile royal family and **The Observatory**. Drive past **Hawa Mahal**, also known as '*The Palace of Winds*', evening hotel transfer, overnight Jaipur.

Day 05 Jaipur – Delhi – Hong Kong

Breakfast at hotel, drive to Delhi (265km / 6.5hrs) airport transfer, depart Delhi, arrive Hong Kong.
