

4N 5D Golden Triangle


Delhi – Agra – Fatehpur Sikri – Jaipur – Delhi

Day 01 Delhi

Arrive Delhi (DEL), meet and greet upon arrival, hotel transfer, overnight Delhi.

Day 02 Delhi

Enjoy breakfast in the comfort of your hotel, your private tour transports you through time from Old Delhi to New Delhi.



Red Fort

Visit **Red Fort**, appropriately named due to the red-sandstone walls, a beautiful *UNESCO World Heritage Site*. Constructed by the Mughal Emperor Shah Jehan with the purpose of being the Emperor's main residence. Located in the heart of Delhi and housing several museums, this was the ceremonial and political center of the Mughal state. Nearby you can see the imperial avenue known as Chandni Chowk.

Continue through ever narrowing alleyways until you end up at the largest Muslim mosque in India, **Jama Masjid**. The full name *Masjid-I Jahan-Numa* translates to *World Reflection Mosque*. Built in the mid-17th century with three towering gates and two tall minarets comprised of strips of white marble and red sandstone. The massive courtyard can accommodate over twenty-five thousand people.

Qutab Minar

End your experience of Old Delhi with a Rickshaw Ride crossing the streets as you are transported into New Delhi with your highlights including **Qutab Minar**, **Humayun's Tomb** and **India Gate**. **Qutab Minar** is a minaret that forms part of Qutab Complex that contains a spiral staircase, construction of the first storey began in the late 12th century.

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India Gate is a war memorial on the eastern edge of New Delhi, a tribute to tens of thousands of soldiers from the British Indian Army who fought in the First World War. The architectural style is often compared to the Arc de Triomphe in Paris and The Gateway of India in Mumbai.

Drive past Rashtrapati Bhawan, originally made to be the imperial residence of the Viceroy in the early 20th century, currently the home for Parliament House and the President of India. The unique circular design was constructed with huge colonnades housing the Lower and Upper House of Parliament.

Your final point of interest is **Lotus Temple**, notable for the flowerlike shape. Hotel transfer, overnight Delhi.

Day 03 Delhi – Agra

After breakfast, check-out and drive to Agra (approx. 210km / 04hrs), check-in and relax.



Agra Fort

Your private tour takes you to **Agra Fort**, situated on the banks of the Yamuna River. This imposing structure is replete with priceless examples of Mughal period craftsmanship. See the beautiful pearl mosque from the 16th century at this dominating fortress.

Continue to the **Taj Mahal**, an ivory white marble mausoleum that has become an icon representing the country. In Hindi *Taj Mahal* translates to *Crown of the Palaces*, an epic masterpiece created to house the tomb of the Mughal emperor's wife.

Formal gardens bounded on three sides by a crenelated wall can also be found here.

Hotel transfer, overnight Agra.

Day 04 Agra – Fatehpur Sikri – Jaipur

Hotel breakfast, check-in and transfer to Jaipur (approx. 240km / 06hrs), stop by Fatehpur Sikri on the way to stretch your legs and explore this interesting place.

Fatehpur Sikri is a beautiful city with a fascinating origin story, here you will learn about the Muslim Saint, Sheikh Salim Chishti and how this place was named. Visit the **Mosque of Salim Chishti, Panch Mahal** and the other Palaces.

Continue to Jaipur and see the intricate **Maharaja's City Palace** and the astonishing **Jantar Mantar (Observatory)**. Drive past Hawa Mahal (*Palace of Winds*) built at the end of the 18th century and see **Jal Mahal (Palace on the Lake)**.

Hotel transfer, overnight Jaipur.

Day 05 Jaipur – Delhi



Amber Fort

We recommend a hearty breakfast as your final day has the best saved for last. Your guide shall escort you to **Amber Fort** where you shall ascend like royalty on elephants (*subject to availability, otherwise jeep ride provided*). Peruse this interesting blend of Muslim and Hindu architecture from the 16th century and see the strong red sandstone and white marble composition. **Jai Mandir, Sheesh Mahal, Sukh Niwas, Ganesh Pol** and **Temple of Kali** are all points of interest here.

Check-out and drive to Delhi (260km / 06hrs), airport transfer for your onward flight.
