Day 01 Nairobi



Arrive in Nairobi, hotel transfer to the luxurious Fairmont The Norfolk.

Welcome to Kenya's most famous hotel tucked away in the heart of Nairobi, welcoming generations of safari enthusiasts since 1904. Overnight **Fairmont The Norfolk, Nairobi**.

Day 02 Amboseli National Park

Enjoy breakfast in the comfort of your hotel, drive to **Amboseli National Park** at the base of towering snow-capped Mount Kilimanjaro, famous for being the highest freestanding mountain in the world.

Your expedition takes you across the region, spot spectacular wildlife including cheetahs, leopards and African savanna elephants all roaming around freely. Venture to their nearby swamps, springs and a shimmering dried lakebed.

Enjoy a Welcome Dinner in the evening with your fellow guests and toast to the beginning of an amazing safari adventure, overnight **Tawi Lodge**, Nairobi.



Day 03 Amboseli National Park

Camp breakfast, spend the day exploring **Amboseli National Park**, try to find the amazing buffalos and lions that roam the lands. Enjoy your morning on safari prior to breaking for lunch. Afterwards head out on another Game Drive that ends with a refreshing sundowner. Overnight Tawi Lodge, Nairobi.

Day 04 Tarangire National Park, Tanzania

Breakfast at camp, transfer to the Tanzanian Border with a break for lunch at Arusha. Airport transfer for your direct flight from Arusha to **Tarangire**National Park, check-in and settle into this luxurious property.

The large tens are built on raised decks under umbrella acacia trees that overlook the Gurusi flood pains. The layout is quite open and resident hers of impalas sometimes can be seen grazing in camp.

See the amazing view where wide panoramas of wooded savanna stretch out in every direction, nearby the Tarangire River is considered home to big game including elephants, buffalo and lions.

End the evening with dining in the camp, overnight **Sanctuary Swala**.

Day 05 Tarangire National Park, Tanzania

We recommend a hearty breakfast as you embark on morning and afternoon game drives where comfortable vehicle seats six to ensure that every guest enjoys a window seat. Explore **Tarangire**National Park with the red hued Great Rift Valley in the background. Discover herds of elephants, fast moving zebras and sly pythons that hide above in sausage trees.

As dusk approaches you can also enjoy an optional evening safari where the nocturnal creatures, rarely seen by visitors, come out. Look for the sneaky African wildcat, the elusive leopards and the round eyes of a bush baby. Aided with specialized lighting your guides will advise you how to spot for smaller animals such as genets, bat-eared foxes and nightjars.

We recommend taking part in a **Chef's Table Experience** which covers a cooking demonstration for local delicacies such as *makande*, *kachumbari* and *ugali*. The best part is, undoubtably, tasting your meal afterwards! Overnight Sanctuary Swala.

Day 06 Ngorongoro Crater

Enjoy breakfast in the comfort of your luxury camp, discover the life of locals on this enlightening day tour. Head to the village of **Mto wa Mbu** as you ride like a local by tuk-tuk, see rice fields and a banana plantation, sip on banana beer at a local bar. Walk through the local market which provides beautifully colourful produce. After lunch in the village, transfer to **Ngorongoro Crater** for your stay at a restful luxury lodge nearby.

Day 07 Ngorongoro Crater

Breakfast at camp, full day Game Drive in Ngorongoro Crater, explore panoramic views, short-grass prairies along the floor of this ancient volcanic caldera which is home to lions, hyenas and rare black rhinos.



The area is also a *UNESCO World Heritage Site* due to the abundance of wildlife within as well as the Maasai herdsmen that roam the land. In the afternoon you will be escorted to a **Maasai Village** to learn about the local culture and traditions. See traditional beadworks during an artisan visit and meet with an elder who can answer any questions you may have.

Day 08 – 10 Serengeti National Park

For the next three days you will witness the annual **Great Migration** where millions of herbivores journey across the Serengeti Plains looking for fresh grass and water and where predators search and hunt for prey. Drive to **Serengeti National Park** with a private archaeological guided tour to **Olduvai Gorge** on the way.

During these days you may see wildebeests, elephants, giraffes and more on your morning and afternoon Game Drives. If you like, you can also choose a Hot Air Balloon ride across the Serengeti for a unique perspective on the area.

Day 11 Masai Mara Game Reserve

After your breakfast in the camp, transfer to the airport for your flight to Masai Mara, upon arrival you will be escorted to your riverside camp. Embark on an afternoon Game Drive and notice the contrasting wildlife to the last few days as you follow the **Mara River** to find crocodiles bathing in the sun, mischievous monkeys above and hungry hippos in the muddy waters. Over 500 species of birds reside here including elegant eagles.



While in the Mara, relax at Sanctuary Olonana, one of the finest safari lodges Africa offers. Spend each evening in your large suite housing rain showers en suite, large tubs, folding floor to ceiling glass doors and a private veranda. Join your fellow guests in the evening for a Scenic Sundowner and an elegant dinner.

Day 12 – 13 Masai Mara Game Reserve

Spend the next two days exploring the open savanna, tree-fringed rivers of the Masai Mara and the incredible woodlands. Patience when viewing will be rewarded; you may see elephants protecting their young from predatory lions or leopards that pounce from acacia branches high above, never a dull moment in the Mara.

Witness the annual Great Migration, see tribesmen cross the plains and herd cattle as the wildlife shifts

dramatically. You will have another opportunity to take a hot air balloon ride over the Mara.
