

## Peru 07 Nights / 08 Days

### Lima, Valle, Sagrado & Cuzco

#### Day 01 Lima

Arrive Lima (LIM), meet and greet, hotel transfer, overnight Lima.

#### Day 02 Lima – Cuzco

Enjoy breakfast in the comfort of your hotel prior to your **Half Day City Tour**. See the modern and colonial parts of the city of Lima, known as the *City of Kings*, starting in the districts of Miraflores and San Isidro. The road passes a **Huaca** or sacred pre-Inca site. Stop at **Parque del Amor** (*Lovers Park*) in Miraflores for a magnificent view over the Pacific Ocean.

Your tour also includes the **Historic Centre** based on the Main Square, where the **Presidential Palace**, **Archbishop's Palace**, the **Municipality of Lima** and the **Cathedral** are located, as well as a visit to one of the largest colonial-era convents.

Airport transfer, depart Lima (LIM), arrive Cuzco (CUZ), meet and greet, hotel transfer, overnight Cuzco.

#### Day 03 Cuzco



**Koricancha**

Hotel breakfast, your **Half Day Walking Tour** begins, explore the imposing Imperial City, an example of the harmonious coexistence of the Andean and Spanish cultures. Begin at the **Koricancha**, an ancient sacred space that the Incas dedicated to the worship of the sun and the moon, and over which the congregation of the Dominicans built the Santo Domingo temple.

Continue to the **Main Square**, located across the imposing Cathedral and the magnificent Jesuite church, as well as other colonial buildings, which all together compose one of the most beautiful and captivating sceneries in Peru. Your tour will finish with a visit to the bohemian neighborhood of **San Blas**, known also as *The Artists' District*, a hub for popular artisans, with narrow and winding streets, popular art shops and crafts stores.

## Day 04 Cuzco



**Huaypo Lagoon**

Breakfast as hotel, start the day with a **Half Day Kayaking Tour in Huaypo Lagoon**, enjoy a unique experience kayaking in the lagoon of Huaypo, located in the plains of Chinchero, at 3700 meters, on the way to the Sacred Valley of the Incas.

Enjoy spectacular scenery and get in touch with pure nature.

**Half Day Tour Misminay with Brunch**, visit the Misminay community, located in the **Sacred Valley of the Incas**. The townspeople will give you a warm welcome with music and dance. Experience the Andean lifestyle up-close, sharing some of their daily tasks. You will have the chance of participating in an agricultural session, learn about working the land, as well as techniques and tools inherited from the Incas and that are still being used until today. Participate in a ceremony to thank Pachamama (*Mother Earth*) for food and abundance to community. Learn about different products harvested before enjoying a delicious brunch made with local ingredients.

## Day 05 Cuzco

Enjoy breakfast in the comfort of your hotel, embark on a **Full Day Moray Maras Highlands Mountain Bike Adventure**. You will be picked up to start the route to the Sacred Valley of the Incas, until you get to **Cruzpata** in the **Pampas of Chinchero**. From here, you will begin your exciting bicycle tour from the **Huaypo Lagoon** to reach the experimental Agricultural Site of Moray.

The journey continues toward the town of **Maras** where you will enjoy a picnic lunch and follow the way to the **Salt Mines**. This unforgettable experience finishes with a 30-40 minute descent to **Pichingoto**, crossing the Urubamba River, where a private bus will take you back to your hotel.

## Day 06 Cuzco – Aguas Calientes



**Aguas Calientes**

Hotel breakfast, Train Station transfer, **Machu Picchu by Vistadome Train Adventure**, visit one of the most important tourist destinations in the world: **Machu Picchu**. The excursion starts with a train trip to the town of **Aguas Calientes**, also known as Machu Picchu Pueblo. The natural beauty of the surroundings makes the train the best way to start your visit.

When you arrive, start the ascent to the ruins, which will be, without a doubt one of your most unforgettable experiences. At **Machu Picchu** see one of the *Seven Modern Wonders of the World* and take some impressive photos. Then it is back down to Aguas Calientes for lunch in a local restaurant. **Day 07 Aguas Calientes – Cuzco**

Breakfast at hotel, journey on a **Full Day Huayana Picchu Tour**, explore **Machu Picchu**, a national sanctuary, *UNESCO World Cultural Heritage site*, and one of the *New Seven Wonders of the World*.

After an amazing day of discovery among this architectural masterpiece, you can choose to come back the following day (this includes the entrance fee to Machu Picchu and the bus ticket) to climb to the top of **Mount Huayna Picchu** (2667 meters), **Quechua** for *Young Mountain*, on the eastern side of the Central Cordillera. This peak shelters another archaeological site, the **Temple of the Moon**, that is connected to Machu Picchu and is a marvel in its own right for the wondrous underground galleries built there. Later that afternoon, you will ride the train back to the station indicated in your ticket.
