Day 1 - Delhi - Agra

Welcome on-board the *Maharaja Express*, in the evening you shall assemble at *Safdarjung Railway station* at approx. 2030hrs, you shall complete your registration, proceed with the check-in formalities and then enjoy a nice relaxing welcome drink.

You will **depart** at approx. **2200hrs** from **Delhi** to **Agra**, dinner shall be served on board and you will spend the night on comfortable luxury train.

Dinner on-board the Maharaja Express will be included.

Day 2 – Agra – Ranthambore



Taj Mahal

Enjoy your morning meal on-board the luxury train as you arrive in Agra, your first stop today will be one of the Seven Wonders of the World, **The Taj Mahal**. The beautiful mausoleum of white marble has been standing tall since 1648, built by order of the Mughal emperor *Shah Jahan*, in memory of this wife. This UNESCO *World Heritage Site* is framed by trees and on a clear day is beautifully reflected in the pool near the entrance. Your visit will conclude with a champagne breakfast atop *Taj Khema*.

You may choose to either return to the *Maharaja Express* or go on an optional tour of *Fatehpur Sikiri* or *Itmad-ud-Daulah*, lunch will be served on board.



After your afternoon meal on board you will be escorted to **Agra Fort**. Similar in design to the *Red Fort* in Delhi, however the former is better preserved, constructed mainly from red sandstone serving as both a palace and defensive structure. Emperor *Akbar*, who was king at 14, ordered the construction in 1565, it took six years to complete. The view from up top is worth checking out.

You may choose to head to spa facilities at a five star hotel, on your own accord, or an optional private shopping tour for pietra dura marble and fine Mughal jewellery. Spend the night on board your train as you are escorted to *Ranthambore National Park*.

Breakfast at Taj Khema will be included. Lunch and dinner on-board the Maharaja Express will be included.

<u>Day 3 – Ranthambore – Jaipur</u>

Awaken in Sawai, Madhopur in the morning, today you will journey on a safari tour to **Ranthambore National Park**. Welcome to the Maharajas private hunting grounds, declared a national park in 1973, many wildlife creatures including tigers, wild boars, hyenas, jackal and leopards are all spread throughout. You will be served breakfast at Vivanta by Taj, Sawai Madhour prior to heading back to your train which shall depart to Jaipur.

the city is famous for.

In the late morning you will arrive in Jaipur, a colourful city built by *Raja Jai Singh* in the 18th century, famous for towering palaces, strong forts and intricate temples. After lunch on-board the train disembark and head to the **Amber Fort**. The highlight of the city, admire the incredible blend of Hindu and Mughal architecture. Construction began in 1592, red sand stone and white marble was used, and his rugged forbidding exterior belies an inner paradise with a beautiful fusion of art and architecture. Enjoy your tour of the place which concludes with an opportunity to peruse some of the finest jewellery, textiles and blue pottery that

If you wish you may join one of the optional tours of using the spa facilities at a five star hotel or a private shopping tour or golfing at the *Rambagh Golf Club* or visiting the *City Palace & Jantar Mantar*.



The day will end with an enthralling elephant polo exhibition match where you will experience a royal welcome, at the *Jai Mahal Palace* hotel. You shall be greeted by the royal military band and the beating of *Nagadas*. Guests may participate in the exhibition game, which will be followed by a champagne dinner at the hotel.

Once ready, return to your train for your overnight stay, next stop; Bikaner.

Breakfast at Vivanta by Taj, Sawai Madhopur will be included.


Lunch on-board the Maharaja Express will be included.

Elephant Polo with champagne dinner at the Jai Mahal Palace hotel will be included.

Day 4 – Jaipur – Bikaner – Jodhpur

You will journey through the desert as your enter Bikaner, once a major centre in the cross desert caravan trade, known as *Camel Country*, famous for the best camels in the world. Peruse the multiple palaces and temples, comprised of red and yellow sandstone, living reflections of the districts rich historical and architectural legacy.

In the late morning upon your arrival you may choose to relax on board or embark on one of the optional tours; either visit the *Lalgarh Palace Museum*, where fascinating exhibits on the royal heritage of Bikaner are on display or take an excursion to the *Karni Mata Temple* in Deshnok, known as *Rat Temple*, due to the

hundreds of rats swarming the courtyard. Another option which we recommend is the *Camel Breeding Farm*, which opens at 1200hrs.

Savour your lunch on-board the *Royal Maharaja* prior to heading to **Junagarh Fort**, an unassailable fortress that was built in 1593 by *Raja Rai Singh*. There is much to see inside this immense structure. Later on you can participate in a camel cart procession followed by Sundowner cocktails, a tasty barbeque and mesmerizing folk performances on the sand dunes.

Get back on your train in the evening as you are escorted onwards to Jodhpur.

Breakfast and lunch on board the Maharaja Express will be included. Sundowner cocktails and a barbeque dinner on the sand dunes will be included.



<u>Day 5 – Jodhpur – Udaipur</u>

Today you shall awaken in the Marwar region, enjoy a leisurely breakfast on board your train as you pass through some of the picturesque landscapes of the *Thar Desert* as you arrive into Jodhpur. The rest of the morning has been left open to do as you please, you may participate in an optional village safari where you will have the opportunity to visit a *Bishnoi village*, considered to be the oldest living environmentalist community in the world. The other option is heading to a spa at a fiver star hotel on your own accord.

Lunch will be served on board prior to the tour continuing on foot starting with the **Old Clock Tower** and **Sadar Market**. Experience the lively hustle and bustle of the market where locals can be seen participating in trading goods.



Mehrangarh Fort

Continue to **Mehrangarh Fort**, an impressive landmark of the city, consisting of intricately latticed windows, elaborately carved panels and elegantly curved porches. Priceless jewels and a dazzling collection of arms are all on display.

End the day with a royal cocktail dinner at *Hanwant Mahal* where folk dance and music can be enjoyed among sumptuous Marwari culinary treats. Head back to your train where you will spend the night sleeping as you are taken to Udaipur.

Breakfast and lunch on board the Maharaja Express will be included.

<u>Day 6 – Udaipur - Balasinor</u>

Awake in the beautiful region of Udaipur, Mewar; enjoy your breakfast as the wonderful *Aravali Hills* roll past your window. Udaipur is considered the *Venice of the East* due to her enchanting white marble palaces, placid lakes and green hills. Your tour begins with a visit to the **City Palace**, the largest palace complex in Rajasthan. Scalloped arches, fretted balconies and cupolas can all be found here.

Next up is the **Crystal Gallery**, the Udaipur collection of valuable crystal is one of the largest and most complete collections of Osler cut glass in the world. The majority of this collection was commissioned by *Maharana Saijan Singh* in 1878.

Experience royal hospitality at **Satkar Hall** of *Fatesh Prakash Palace* where your sumptuous lunch will be served, a spread of international cuisine will be available.

After lunch head back to the train to relax and unwind, you will have the option of using spa facilities at a five star hotel on your own accord or visiting the Vintage Car collection of the Royal

Family or a private shopping tour. Later in the afternoon if you wish you may proceed with a walking tour through the old markets.

In the evening return to the *Maharaja Express* where you will sleep peacefully as you are taken to Balasinor.

Breakfast and dinner on board the Maharaja Express will be included. Lunch at Satkar Hall of Fateh Prakash Palace will be included.



Day 7 – Balasinor - Mumbai

In the morning you will arrive in Balasinor, a tiny own in Gujarat, home to one of the largest dinosaur fossil sites in the world. Palaeontologists believe that at least seven species of dinosaurs lived here and researchers have uncovered fossils of about 10,000 dinosaur eggs, making this one of the third largest hatchery in the world. This incredible site was accidently discovered in 1981 when geologists were conducting a mineral survey of the area.



Head to the **Dinosaur Fossil Park** followed by a village visit prior to a lunch meeting with the Royal Family where you can relish their unique cuisine. After saying goodbye head back on board the train for your final overnight stay as you are taken to Mumbai.

Day 8 - Mumbai
