- → FUXING PARK Located in the former French Concession of Shanghai and features a lake, fountains, pavilions and an abundance of flowers.
- → SINAN ROAD, TIANZIFANG An arts and crafts cultural hub in the former French Concession district of Shanghai that features quaint shops, cafés, galleries and art studios.
- → **JADE BUDDHA TEMPLE** Where you can see the two statues that were imported and learn about the Buddhist faith.
- → M50 ART STREET Has since become a desirable destination to visit in its own right, with countless studios and galleries occupying the former industrial spaces alongside edgy restaurants and cafés and quirky street sculptures and graffiti murals.

As the town covers 33 hectares which include a total of 55 of eye-catching bridges, beautiful sights such as the Qing-era Tuisi Garden, Hand crank boat, Net Master Garden, which is a residential garden that dates back to the Southern Song period. You will also see Pingjiang Road and take a rickshaw tour along old town, the better way to see the ancient city road of Pingjiang.
