DAY ONE HONG KONG - KATHMANDU

Your flight (CX 603) departs Hong Kong at 19:35, arriving at **Kathmandu** at 22:30. You'll be met by a representative and privately transferred to your hotel.

DAY TWO KATHMANDU

Enjoy a morning breakfast before visiting **Boudhanath Stupa,** one of the oldest and largest Buddhist monuments in Nepal. Tens of thousands of pilgrims visit the stupa each year.

From there you will move on to Swayambhunath Temple, which has been a religious site for over 1500 years. The hill itself is a mosaic of small Chaityas and Pagoda temples with a scenic view of Kathmandu.

Continue onwards to see Patan City. also known as Lalitpur. A destination for connoisseurs of fine arts, Patan is filled with wood and stone carvings and ornate architecture, including dozens of Buddhist and Hindu temples, and over 1200 monuments.

DAY THREE KATHMANDU - CHITWAN

After breakfast at your hotel, you will check out and be privately transferred for your flight to **Chitwan**.



The Royal Chitwan National Park, located in a lush valley, houses the first national park ever established in Nepal. It is famous for its variety of wildlife, including the great Indian Rhinoceros and the elusive Royal Bengal Tiger. The park is home for more that 50 mammal species, over 525 birds, and 55 amphibians and reptiles, including several endangered species.

DAY EIGHT KATHMANDU
