Day 01 Merida



Uxmal

Continue to the ruins of **Kabah**, a Mayan archaeological site connected to Uxmal by a raised pedestrian causeway.

Head to **Yokdzonot Cenote** for a refreshing swim, scrub or diving in natural sinkholes resulting from the collapse of limestone bedrock that exposes fresh water underneath. Hotel transfer, overnight Merida.

Today you will be guided to explore the archaeological site, Mayan ruins at **Uxmal** and **Kabah**, as a *UNESCO World Heritage Site*, **Uxmal** is one of the impressive restored ruins in the Yucatan Peninsula.

The ruins give a glimpse into Mayan history, learn about the Rain God, Chaac on the facade of the Palace of the Mask, an interesting education about the Mayan inhabitants who once thrived here centuries ago.

Day 02 Merida – Chichen Itza



Tixkokob

Enjoy breakfast in the comfort of your hotel, check-out and drive to **Tixkokob** (approx. 30 mins) see how local families practice the age-old tradition of hammock weaving.

One of the most valued handcrafts made by the indigenous communities in the Yucatan Peninsula is the hammock, they represent more than 700 families in the area.

Most of the hammocks for sale in Yucatan are handmade in family workshops, you will have chance to meet a local artisan family's workshop and discover from the expert the secrets and techniques to best lie in a hammock. Hotel transfer, overnight Chichen Itza.

Day 03 Chichen Itza – Holbox Island

Around 8:30 am your private tour of Chichen Itza begins, welcome to one of the largest archaeological cities of the Pre Columbian Maya civilization. Experience the Maya Tour with Mayan Numerology Lessons, learn the numerical Mayan base and understand how the ancient Mayas calculated the time, astronomy and mathematics.

See archaeological temples, admires magnificent monuments such as **the Observatory**, **the Nunnery**, where the famous **Temple of**

Kukulcan is located, the remarkable Ball Game Court, Temple of the Jaguars, Temple of the Warriors and adjacent Temple of the 1,000 columns.

You will be taught how to cook authentic Mayan food while having a Mayan Language Lesson! Share with your family & friends when you return home, as the Mayan language is a living language! Head to Chiquila Ferry Point (approx. 2.5hrs), connect to Holbox Island by boat (approx. 2hrs), hotel transfer, overnight Isla de Holbox.

Day 04 Holbox Island



Isla Pasion

Embark on a **Boat Tour** to **Isla Pajaros**, **Isla Pasion** and **Yalahau Spring**, during the excursion you will see more than 35 species of nesting birds on Isla Pajaros including frigates and pelicans.

Hear about bird migration patterns and breeding behaviors from your bird loving guide.

Journey to Isla Pasion to see resident flamingos, enjoy a swim in the cenote (freshwater sinkhole at Yalahau) and once you are ready, return back to your hotel. Overnight Isla de Holbox.

Day 05 Holbox Island

Experience a **Whale Shark Tour**, swim with the biggest fish in the world, a truly incredible adventure!

Continue with you **Bioluminescence Kayaking Tour** where you will see a sparkling phosphorescence on the surface of disturbed water. This incredible night tour leaves your skin glittering like the stars and your movements creating patterns of shining light. Hotel transfer, overnight Isla de Holbox.

Day 06 Holbox – Riviera Maya

After breakfast, check out, ferry to Chiquila Ferry Point and car to Riviera Maya (approx. 2hrs), hotel transfer, overnight Riviera Maya.

Day 07 Riviera Maya

Head to **Akumal Bay** and enjoy **Snorkeling with Turtles** at Yal Ku Lagoon, a unique snorkeling adventure in the coastal lagoon.

This area has calm waters with enough fish and sea life to keep even the advance snorkeler entertained for the day! Enjoy a leisurely day here until your evening hotel transfer, overnight Riviera Maya.

After lunch, you will be guided to the depths of **Rio Secreto**, journey to the underground world of the Riviera Maya where you will discover incredible rock formations sharped by time. You may have a chance to swim in an underground river and tour the caverns in a relaxing environment, where silence surrounds this place allowing one to admire the beautiful stalactites and stalagmites decorating the walls, a truly memorable experience!

Airport transfer for your onward journey.

Transfer to **Tulum** (approx. 50mins) explore the magical ruins as you walk among the incredible buildings that the Mayan people raised by the coast. Learn the history of the archaeological site and discover how it became the most important port of their time. See beautiful decoration styles on the and dazzle yourself with marvelous views of the beach framing this ancient city.
