

## EXPLORE MANILA'S HISTORICAL AND CULTURAL HERITAGE



### DAY ONE HONG KONG - MANILA

- Arrive Ninoy Aquino International Airport (MNL), meet your personal local guide and start your tour.
- **BONIFACIO HIGH STREET** A 1-kilometer-long boulevard line with exceptional shopping and dining options. Bonifacio High Street is the first ever shopping centre in the country to introduce the main street concept. It is the home of a multitude of passions ranging from fashion, health and beauty, technology, dining, and more.
- **AMERICAN CEMETERY** The Manila American Cemetery and Memorial occupies 152 acres on a prominent plateau, visible at a distance from the east, south and west. It contains the largest number of graves of our military dead of World War II, a total of 16,859, most of whom lost their lives in operations in New Guinea and the Philippines. The headstones are aligned in 11 plots forming a generally circular pattern, set among masses of a wide variety of tropical trees and shrubbery.
- **VENICE GRAND CANAL AND MARKET SHOPPING MALL**  
This Venice-inspired mall draws thousands of travellers for its fine architecture and replica of Italy's Grand Canal—the main centrepiece here. In this open-air mall, you can get on a traditional gondola ride with singing gondoliers, hang a love lock along Ponte de Amore Bridge, and roam around the bazaars and novelty shops for food and unique souvenirs
- After your tour, proceed to a local restaurant for dinner. Afterwards proceed to hotel for check-in.





## DAY TWO MANILA

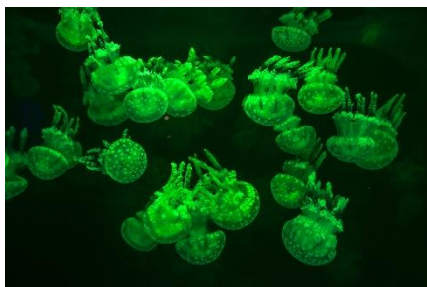
- After your hotel breakfast, meet your personal local guide at the hotel lobby.
- **INTRAMUROS** The Walled City of Intramuros in Manila was built by the Spaniards some 400 years ago as their political and military base in Asia.
- **MANILA CATHEDRAL** First built in 1571, Manila Cathedral is recognized as the main Roman Catholic Church in the Philippines.
- **PLAZA DE GOBERNADOR** Former home of the Governor-General during the colonization of the Spaniards in the country.
- **SAN AGUSTIN CHURCH** The oldest church in the Philippines. The church, together with the monastery nearby, was one of the only structures left standing after World War II.
- **CASA MANILA** A replica of Spanish colonial mansion of 19th century Manila. It recreates the rich merchant's way during the Spanish colonization, showcasing period furniture coming from Chinese, European, and Philippine origins.
- **BALUARTE DE SAN DIEGO** A spade-shaped bulwark- this fort was created from the remains of the upper portion of a circular watch tower built from 1586-1587.
- **NATIONAL MUSEUM** Comprises the National Museum of Fine Arts, the National Museum of Anthropology, the National Museum of Natural History, and the National Planetarium, as well as branches of the museum throughout the Philippines. It's also an educational, cultural, and scientific institution and offers lectures, interviews, and publications and conducts various research programs.
- **LUNETA PARK** Rizal Park, widely known as Luneta Park is an iconic park that carries with it a rich history, as it is the location where the country's National Hero, Dr. Jose Rizal was executed. One of the largest recreational parks in Asia, the 58-hectare park is situated at the northern part of Roxas Boulevard



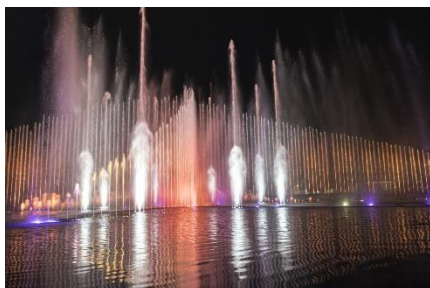


### DAY THREE MANILA

- **MANILA OCEAN PARK** Philippines' first world-class marine theme park and education facility. Waiting for you inside are a wide variety of aquatic attractions, exciting activities, and interactive shows, all of which cater to locals and tourists of all ages. Take the opportunity to observe sharks, birds, stingrays, and meet other friendly animals, or walk through a number of exhibits that will expand your knowledge about marine life all over the world.
- **OKADA MANILA FOUNTAIN SHOW** One of the world's largest multicolour dancing water features measuring 37,464 square meters—as expansive as 50 Olympic-sized pool.
