DAY ONE HONG KONG - ZURICH

Arrive and be driven to **Lucerne**, a picturesque city in Switzerland amid white-capped mountains, best known for its well-preserved medieval architecture. Take part in a walking tour where you will view the colourful **Altstadt** (Old Town). See the Chapel Bridge, built in the 14th century, the Spreuer Bridge (15th century), and the twin needle towers of the Church of St Ledoegar, the city's patron saint.



DAY TWO ZURICH - MOUNTAIN RIGI

Breakfast in the morning before departing to see **Mount Rigi**, the most visited peak in the Swiss Alps. The highest viewing point sits at an incredible elevation of 1800 meters, providing stunning vistas. Take a cute boat trip to the village **Vitznau** and from there embark on Europe's first cogwheel train to the top of the mountain for an alpine view before descending back to Lucerne by cable car



DAY THREE LUCERNE

Start with visiting the **Lindt chocolate museum**, followed by a cargo bike tour through the gorgeous landscape where you will explore the back roads and quiet lakeside trails. You can even have hands-on fun with e-bikes in the remote villages; an authentic Swiss experience for the family and a great way to explore the area. From the 17th of November to 23rd December a visit to the **Lucerne Christmas Market** is a must. Guests young and old can look forward to a variety of cuisines as well as Christmas gift shopping amid handicraft vendors, all framed by a view of Lake Lucerne. End in a cosy **fondue chalet**, enticing you with a variety of authentic Swiss cheeses.

DAY FOUR LUCERNE – JUNGFRAUJOCH

take the **Eiger Express**, a spectacular gondola ride with soaring views of the Eiger. Continue with a cogwheel train to the top of the magnificent **Jungfraujoch**, the 'Maiden Saddle', a glacier saddle connecting the Jungfrau and Monch mountains on the Bernese Alps. At over 3,400 meters above sea level, you will see why it is called the "Top of Europe". Experience attractions such as the **Sphinx Observation Deck**, the **Ice Palace**, **the Snow Fun Park**, **the Lindt Swiss Chocolate Heaven** and more. Return and visit the quaint and gorgeous village of **Lauterbrunnen**, ensconced by primal cliffs and enchanting waterfalls. Stop for some souvenirs in **Interlaken** before staying overnight in Lucerne.

DAY FIVE LUCERNE - ZERMATT



After a morning breakfast, check out for a scenic drive to **Zermatt** (approx. 4 hrs.). Experience the vital Swiss landscape through its picturesque mountain valleys over towering cliff sides, and past verdant forests. Check in to your hotel and embark on a walking tour in the beautiful town, the highlights of which include the **Parish Church of St. Mauritius** and the **Matterhorn Museum**. Finish with the chance to admire stunning views over **the Gorner Gorge**. Stay overnight at the Alpen Resort and Spa

DAY SIX ZERMATT – MATTERHORN

The 33 minute ride involves a vertical climb of 1,469 meters, passing over dramatic bridges, winding through tunnels and travelling across forests of larch and Swiss stone pine. View rocky ravines and mountain lakes, catch glimpses of cute marmots, mountains sheep and then top it all off with an unforgettable view from the **Matterhorn**. Enter the Matterhorn multimedia world of experience, an interactive exhibition where you view the Matterhorn from up close through an immersive 3D cinema and virtual paraglider flight. There is also the option to access the pistes and winter hiking paths, which include the highest sledging slope in Switzerland. Additionally, there is an Igloo village to see, or you may undertake a snowshoe tour on the Gornergrat for a taste of pristine, undisturbed nature. Then return to Zurich airport and stay overnight at the Zurich

After breakfast, you will driven to board the spectacular cogwheel train for Europe's highest open-air cog railway.
